Grant Funding for Nottingham Rising Stars Girls' Football Team

Objective:

To secure grant funding to establish and launch the Nottingham Rising Stars Girls' Football Team, which will provide a safe, inclusive environment for young girls from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in Nottingham.

1. Research Potential Grant Opportunities

Action Steps:

1. Identify Relevant Grants:

3. Build Partnerships and Secure Letters of Support

Action Steps:

1. Identify Key Partners:

- Identify local schools, community organizations, and businesses that could support the Nottingham Rising Stars project.
- Engage with universities (e.g., University of Nottingham, Nottingham Trent University) for volunteer recruitment and potential collaboration.

2. Request Letters of Support:

- Approach identified partners and request letters of support that highlight their commitment to the project and the anticipated community impact.
- Ensure letters are specific to the grant application and emphasize the partner's role in the project's success.

3. Include Support Letters in Grant Applications:

 Attach the letters of support to the grant applications to strengthen the proposal and demonstrate community backing.

Deadline: Week 4-5

4. Finalize and Submit Grant Applications

Action Steps:

1. Review and Edit Applications:

- Proofread the entire proposal to ensure clarity, consistency, and alignment with the grant criteria.
- Review budget figures and ensure all required documents and attachments are included.

2. Submit Applications:

- Submit the grant applications through the appropriate channels (online portal, email, or post) before the specified deadlines.
- o Ensure receipt confirmation is obtained for each submission.

3. Follow-Up:

- Track the status of each application and note any follow-up requirements (e.g., additional information or interviews).
- Set reminders for any required updates or progress reports if the grant application is successful.
